Established in 2014, EFA is helping Encinitas to blossom as a cultural arts hub for the greater North County San Diego area. We work to increase cultural programming, help drive arts education (particularly for the underserved), and support the installment of public art.



# who we are

*EFA provides the following:*

## Cultural Events

### Passport Series

EFA presents events in partnership with the City of Encinitas Arts Division that raise awareness and celebrate the diversity that exists not only in Encinitas, but also throughout San Diego County.

### Encinitas Dia De Los Muertos

Drawing thousands every year with art demonstrations, Mariachi, and a "Community Ofrenda," a public recognition of family and friends, Dia de los Muertos is EFA's most popular cultural event.

## Arts Education

### Ballet Folklorico de San Dieguito

The dance program provides dance education to socioeconomically disadvantaged students, aged 7-16. EFA fundraising assists with instructional costs and costumes, giving valuable access to quality dance education.

### The Student Advisory Council

Consisting of high school students who are committed to increasing the visibility of the arts at their schools, this council advises the board on programs and priorities to increase arts engagement among their peers.

### Mariachi Band

The proposed Mariachi band program will provide music education to socioeconomically disadvantaged students, aged 9-18.

## Public Art

EFA supports the efforts of local artists and community-based arts organizations as well as the City of Encinitas in integrating public art into public spaces through advocacy and fundraising activities.
